Karen Lee Butler, 79, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, passed away on November 6, 2023. She was born on January 4, 1944, in Washington, PA, to the late Carl Monnich and Mary Agnes Kunselman. Karen was a loving wife, mother of five, grandmother of seven, and great-grandmother of two. She always gave generously with her time to her family, her home, and the church.

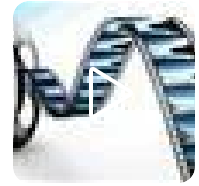
