### **P**hyllis Morton Obituary

A funeral ceremony honoring and remembering Phyllis Morton will be held 2 PM Thursday, August 24, 2023 in the Chapel of South Tulsa Baptist Church. The family will receive friends in the Fellowship Hall following the ceremony. A private interment will be held in Floral Haven Memorial Gardens. Phyllis went to Heaven on Saturday, August 19, 2023. She was 91 years old.

Born June 2, 1932 in St. Louis, Missouri, Phyllis was the daughter of Kenny and Lula Mae Powless. She attended the Salem Community High School in Salem, Illinois, where she graduated with the Class of 1950. Phyllis married Norman Morton November 11, 1952 at the First Baptist Church, also in Salem.

The young couple took the step of faith and headed to Oklahoma. They lived in Stillwater where Phyllis worked as a secretary while Norman studied in the College of Engineering at Oklahoma State University.
