The family will receive visitors from 6-8 PM Monday, June 5, at Bixby-South Tulsa Funeral Service. Carla passed away unexpectedly Tuesday morning, May 30, 2023 in Tulsa. She was 73.

Born March 13, 1950 in Sallisaw, Carla was the daughter of Willis Garland and Wanda Lou (Phillips) Lamb.
