## Elinor Kaplin Obituary

Elinor Gail (Payne) Kaplin, 66 died at St. Francis Hospital Hospice Center on June 7, 2021, surrounded by her husband and three children. She was born on December 14, 1954 to Robert and Josephine Payne in Wichita, Kansas. Elinor attended school in Wichita and graduated from Wichita Heights High School in 1972. She met her husband Randy and they married on October 19, 1974 in Wichita, Kansas. After getting married, the couple moved to Great Bend, Kansas where Randy had recently taken a job with Texaco. The couple resided in Great Bend for 4 years until being transferred to Tulsa, Oklahoma, where the couple made their home for the next 43 years.

Elinor's outward physical beauty was obvious to anyone, but her inward beauty was known to all that she met; always caring and inviting to all who came to know her. She was the personification of inward and outer beauty.
