Ted Pittman Obituary

Teddy Link Pittman was born August 2, 1942, in Eufaula, Oklahoma, the only child to Lincoln and Emma Lee (Johnson) Pittman. Raised on a farm in Stidham, Ted was involved in FFA and played baseball and basketball for the Stidham Redhawks. He would become a high school graduate in 1960. Following graduation, Ted joined the United States Navy serving his country during the Vietnam War. He was stationed in Japan and the Philippines, where he worked on aircraft. Upon his honorable discharge, Ted would return home and marry a childhood friend, Monah West. The two married August 22, 1969, and made their home in Tulsa. Ted sought employment with North American Rockwell, where he was involved in the Apollo 11 moon shot activity. He later began a career as an x-ray service engineer and eventually owned his own business, Pittman Radiographic Service, for more than ten years. The Pittman family eventually made Bixby their home in 1985. Ted was a true electronic buff and could fix anything, but his passion was radios. He held the title of an amateur ham radio operator- earning the amateur extra class ham radio license. Ted was always taking care of others. He is described as kind, gentle, loving, and unselfish. These traits exemplified his strong Christian values. Ted and Monah were long time members of Jenks Church. Ted passed away on August 30, 2020, at his home surrounded by family. Those he leaves to cherish his memory are his wife, Monah Pittman of the home; son, Corey Pittman of Bixby; daughter, Donna Stockton; nine grandchildren, Zac Pittman, Lynnae Gorman, Jeremy Pittman, Larissa Reynolds, Robert Russell, Michael Russell, Morgan Pittman, Jacob Pittman, and Cody Crawford; 11 great-grandchildren; along with a host of other relatives and friends. He was preceded in death by his son, Donald Pittman, parents, and grandparents, Lewis and Ollie Pittman.
