Lense Ramey Obituary

On Tuesday, July 14, 2020, Lense Edward Ramey, Sr., better known as L.E., passed away at the age of 94. L.E. was born in Bixby, Oklahoma, on June 1, 1926, to Virgie (Reynolds) and Stiller Ray Ramey. He joined the United States Navy at the age of 17. He joined the Tulsa Fire Department in 1950 and was a member for 24 years. Additionally, he had various other employment endeavors up until his retirement in 2004. He married Norma Jean Williams on December 7, 1945. They raised one son, Lense Edward Ramey, Jr., and one daughter, Marsha Kathleen Sperling. They moved to Kiefer, Oklahoma in 1957.
