Tina Rogers Obituary

A celebration of Tina's life will take place at 2:00 p.m. Thursday, July 9, 2020 at RiverCrest Chapel and Event Center, Bixby. Tina's family will receive friends for visitation on Wednesday evening from 6:00 - 8:00 p.m. also at RiverCrest. On July 13, 1959, in Clinton, Oklahoma, Tina Rogers was the third of seven children born to Harold and Imogene (Allen) Rogers. The Rogers family would make a move eastward to Okmulgee when Tina was in her youth. It would be in Okmulgee that she would receive her early education - later transferring to Morris, where she became a 1977 high school graduate.
