Donna Teague Obituary

A memorial service honoring and remembering Donna M. Teague will be held 2 PM Saturday, March 21, 2020 at the RiverCrest Chapel in Bixby. Donna passed away Friday, March 6, 2020 at Saint Francis Hospital in Glenpool. She was 83.

Born April 13, 1936 in Stroud, Donna was the daughter of Isaac and Martha (Johnson) Thompson. Along with her 8 siblings, she grew up in Stroud and Okfuskee areas where she worked hard in a farming family. They all got along really well. They had to, there were too many of them! Donna was truly a daddy's girl and known to follow him everywhere.

At an early age, Donna was introduced to Virgil Teague through mutual friends in Frederick, Oklahoma. Both of their families were farming cotton together.
