Patricia Looney Obituary

Pat Looney, 79, passed away peacefully at Saint Francis Hospital on Friday, February 28, 2020. She is the daughter of Ernest H. Ott and Kathleen C. Ott. Pat was a 1959 graduate of Marquette Private School and attended Tulsa University, where she was a member of the Tri-Delta sorority. On April 26, 1960, at Christ the King Catholic Church, Pat married the love of her life and surviving spouse, Burt Looney. Pat and Burt were introduced by lifelong friends Mayo and Mary Andreen and had developed many other life-long friends as she loved everyone she encountered, and they easily loved her back. Pat is also survived by her sons Hal Looney of Phoenix, Arizona and Scott Looney of Tulsa, Oklahoma; her daughter Gretchen and son-in-law Tyler Reeder of Broken Arrow, Oklahoma; her brother Charles Ott of Tulsa, Oklahoma; and seven amazing grandchildren who were her everything: Kathleen and Grant Looney of Phoenix, Arizona; Sydney and Avery Looney of Tulsa, Oklahoma; and Ryvers, Madison and Sheridian Reeder of Broken Arrow, Oklahoma. Pat is also survived by her very close extended family: Brother-in-law Ron and his wife Sue Looney, nephew and niece David Looney and Gina Harris, brother-in-law Bill Stowell and nephew Brett Stowell. Pat was preceded in death by her parents and a brother. Ernest, her dad, was a chiropractor by profession and passed away at the young age 39 when Pat was just nine years old, and Charles only six. Her mom, Kathleen, took the role of being both mom and dad after Ernest passed, and was a very loving and compassionate mother and a devout Catholic in her faith. They were poor, but Pat's mom was one of those people who could turn a nickel into a dollar, so they never went without anything as children. Pat was an active Tri-Delta alumna participating in fundraisers, fashion shows, and other events. She took her family, in their early years, to the Church of the Madalene and then Saint Bernards when it was formed. Saint Bernards was the last place she went to Mass with her entire family before they moved away to other parts of town and the country. She exemplified new Corinthians 13 to the letter. All of us here will miss Pat. We will miss her laugh, her smile, her way of just being Pat. She is gone from us but will live forever in our hearts. The Lord blessed us with the BEST wife, mom, sister, relative, grandmother, and friend. Now, she has returned to the Lord, but will always be in our hearts.
