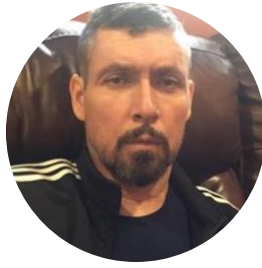

A memorial ceremony honoring the life of Antonio Aleman Rodriguez will be held 2:00 PM Thursday, January 2, 2019 in the Chapel of South Tulsa Baptist Church. Pastor Eric Costanzo will be officiating. Marco passed away December 28, 2019 at Saint Francis Hospital in Tulsa. He was 49. Marco was born in Durango, Mexico on March 11, 1970, the son of Juan Pablo Aleman and Gabriella Rodriguez. He loved to play soccer throughout his childhood and for many years thereafter. Marco met Erika Saucedo while living near her grandfather in Juarez. The couple were married November 14, 1998 also in Juarez. They moved to Tulsa in 2000 where Marco was employed by Oklahoma Landscape for many years.
