Born November 13, 1965, in Dumas, Texas, Lisa was the daughter of Jerral and Carol (McElhaney) Barnes. Carol described Lisa as a compliant, sweet and loving little girl. At the age of three, Lisa's family moved to Duncan, Oklahoma. She attended school in Comanche and became very involved in Future Homemakers of America (FHA), 4-H Club, as well as Future Farmers of America (FFA) where she showed prize-winning sheep. She graduated from Comanche High School with the Class of 1984.

Upon graduation, Lisa moved to Tulsa and was employed with Family Med in Broken Arrow. Through a co-worker, she was introduced to Keith Bolton. Keith, being a handyman, said Lisa would often call seeking help with car troubles. After dating for more than a year, and a casual proposal of "so, do you want to get married?", Lisa and Keith were married on October 6, 1989. Lisa, already a mother to Dustin, would welcome daughters, Samantha and Brooklyne and son, Ethan.

The Bolton family did nearly everything together. Almost every Saturday night, the family was at the racetrack watching Keith.
