Cynthia was a registered nurse for nearly fifty years. She retired as director of nursing in surgery after a forty-year career at St. John in Tulsa.

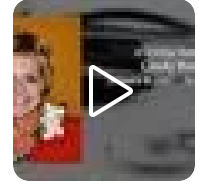

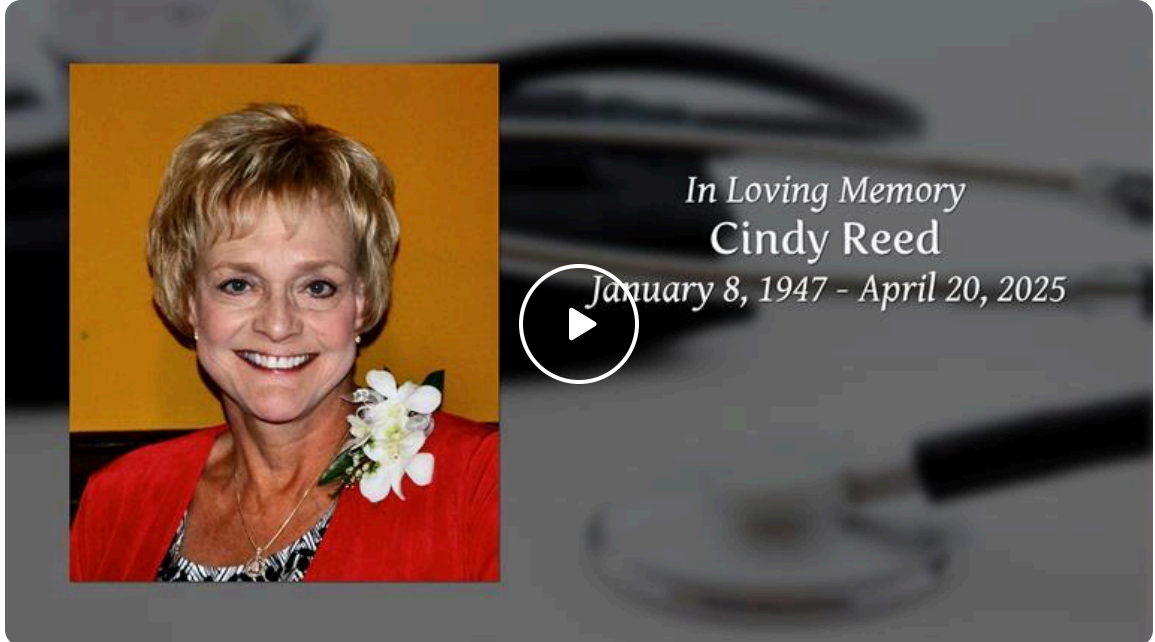
