Jean Ann "Jeanie" Hankins, 66, passed away surrounded by her family on April 15, 2026, leaving behind a legacy of quiet strength, fierce love, and selfless devotion.

Jeanie enjoyed playing softball and participating in the jazz band, where she showcased her musical talents on both the clarinet and saxophone.
